
Farm, City Exchangees Experience Life On The Other Side Of The Fence

worked for his father until age 29. In 1958, Heagy and his wife took ownership. The Heagys milked cows, raised hogs and laying hens, and farmed as many as 700 acres some years. He continues to help his sons with the

farming operation.

"We farm because we like it," Heagy said of the legacy his sons are continuing.

The Century Business Award went to Palmyra Bologna Company begun in 1902. The company started with two employees and now has 55. They have 10 smokehouses each used to process 13,000 pounds of product weekly. The company, the largest producer of Lebanon bologna in the world, offers daily tours and samples.

Additional activity included a sheep-to-shawl auction, which garnered \$300.
