Prices continue to be supported by the holiday demand. One hundred percent of the run went to kill, as prices were well over what feeders are able to pay. An ice storm moved in early Wednesday morning, turning local roads into skating rinks. However, even the cold rains outside could not cool off Wednesday's action. All pigs were weighed and graded on arrival and sold by the hundred weights.
