Report Supplied By USDA Receipts 2076 Last Week 432 Year Ago

There were no pigs that went back to feed last week, therefore a trend will not be available this week. There was some pretty good interest in owning feeders, whether it is to put them on feed long term, or to just hold them until the large holiday runs lessen. The bulk of the very large slaughter pig run sold sharply lower Although it is to be expected when the supply jumps from 400 to over 2000 in a week, as producers try to get them to town to try and hit the good holiday demand. When the supply heavily outweighs the demand, as it did Wednesday, you usually have a pretty big wreck on your hands. However, it could have been worse had there not been several buyers on hand that do need to fill some cooler space for the holiday This is the second large slaughter pig run the area has seen this week, as Carlisle, PA recorded over 1300 head at their graded sale on Monday, with the PA Dept of Ag reporting very good slaughter demand at the early week sale as nearly all of the large run was sent to the kill floor. All pigs were weighed and graded on ar rival and sold by the hundred weights
