

Bidding was active both days as buyers tried to pick up a few before the holiday break. Holstein steers were not well tested but trended with a firmer undertone. Slaughter heifers were in very light supply but also trended a little firmer Breaking and Boning cows sold 50-1 00 higher with lean cows trading fully 1 00-2 00 higher. Buyer with tean cows fracting tune 100-200 inginer buyer activity was very good with higher cow carcass cutout values lending some support as well. There were not enough slaughter bulls for a market test. The supply included 45 percent seers 4 percent heifers. 45 percent cows with the balance feeders.


