USDA Grants Protection To 25 New Plant Varieties

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The USDA has issued certificates of protection to developers of 25 new varieties of seed-reproduced and tuber-propagated plants. They include bean, corn, fescue, lettuce, meadowfoam, oat, sorghum, soybean, and wheat.

The 25 certificates are being issued under the Plant Variety Protection Act. The certificates require that the varieties be new, distinct, uniform, and stable. The owners will have the exclusive right to reproduce, sell, import, and export their products in the U.S. for the duration of protection.


