Perry pointed out that the structural and stylistic details suggest that W.H. was a German-trained artisan." She also noted that records of Hessian soldiers who deserted the British army, during the Revolution, with the initials W.H. settled in northeastern

North Carolina.

Another reason early southern furniture has been difficult to authenticate is that often craftsmen in the back country worked with painters who brought their regional styles with them. A chest in the exhibit, with decoration attributed to painter Johannes Spittler, shows a German influence. It could be confused with the Pennsylvania Dutch chests of the same period (1795-1807).

A good example in the exhibit of the co-mingling of styles and countries is a turned chair. At first glance it appears to be British. Closer inspection shows the turned-spindles of the back set into rails square or rectangular in cross sections: a French technique. It is linked to the more than 250,000 Huguenots who fled France. Some settled in Tidewater, Virginia, while others founded Manakin Town near present-day Richmond.

Tea time was as important in the 18th century South as in England.

Several styles of tea tables evolved. Among the more elegant were those made in Charleston, some with Chippendale's "Chinese" bracket trimmed legs and aprons. Other square types used cutouts of flowers, birds and leaves, while a round, tilt-top might have scalloped edges.

Sometimes styles were combined. One example is a tall clock, c.1809, that is a combination of neoclassical and whimsy. It

seems almost over-embellished with fine carved or inlaid classical urns and eagle. Unexpected are the feet, scrolled like fiddle handles, and the shields with blooming flowers. It was made in the Southern valley of Virginia.

The next time you go to an antique show, play antique detective.

See if any furniture, not labeled as southern, has southern accents.
