ter for the chest, roasted and applied hot to the feet for chilblains, or juiced for cough syrups and ear drops. For chills, hot rocks at the feet, warm blankets and hot teas made with sage, peppermint, or yarrow were prescribed

vegetable stock pepper, to taste French bread slices grated Parmesan cheese (optional)
