### NAME THAT PHASE

Historically, Native Americans kept track of the seasons by giving a distinctive name to full Moons that occurred during important periods of the year. The Algonquin tribes from New England to Lake Superior called the second full Moon of the year the Full Snow Moon (occurring on February 16 this year) because usually the heaviest snows fall during February. Hunting at this time was difficult, so Native Americans also called this the Full Hunger Moon.

### CHOCOLATE SILK PIE

3/4 cup (1 1/2 sticks) butter, softened  
1 1/4 cups sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
1 teaspoon brandy (optional)  
4 ounces unsweetened chocolate, melted  
3 eggs  
graham cracker or chocolate crumb piecrust  
additional hard chocolate, to grate
