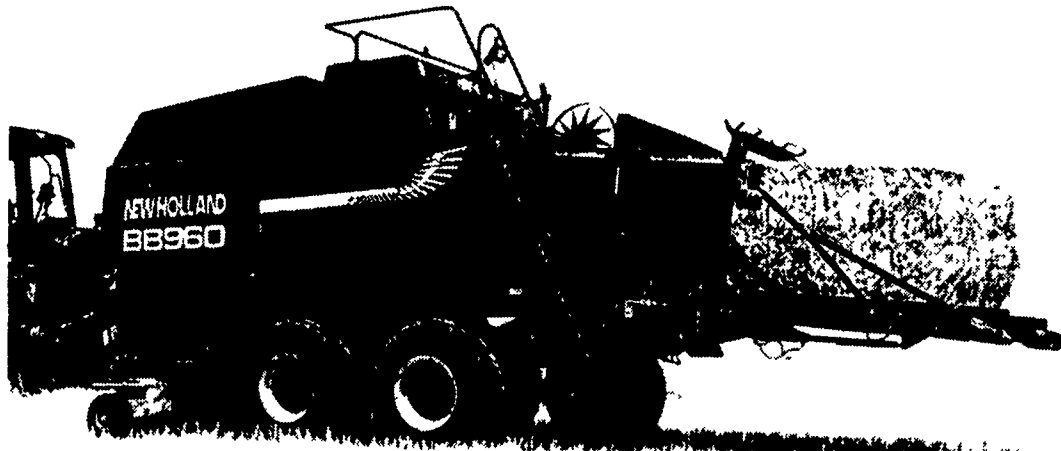

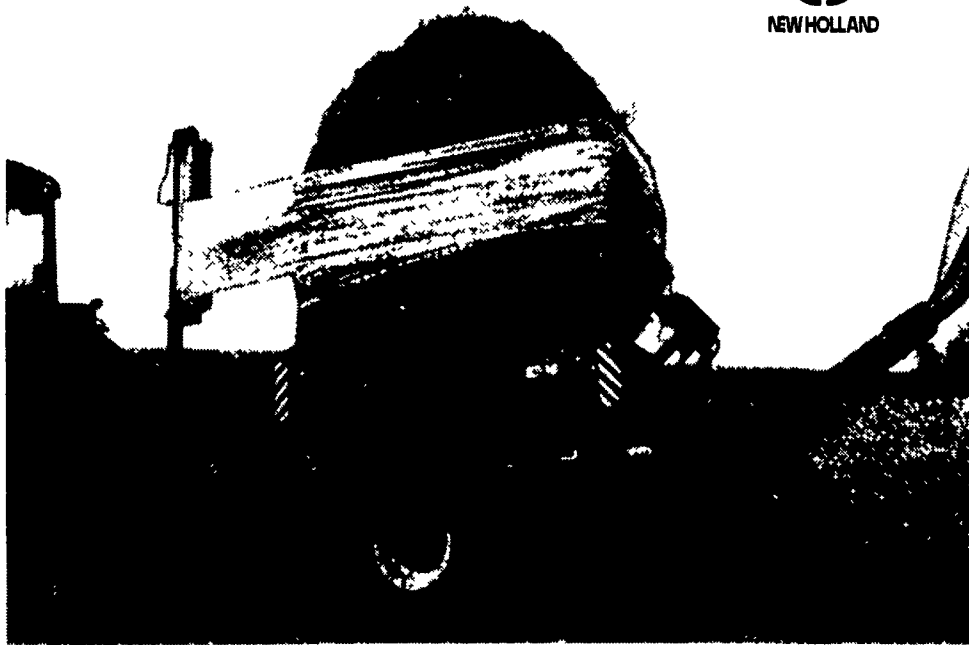

Two models offer a side-mounted lifting arm, three-belt turntable, two large side-support rollers, and cable controls. The B37P is available with computer controls



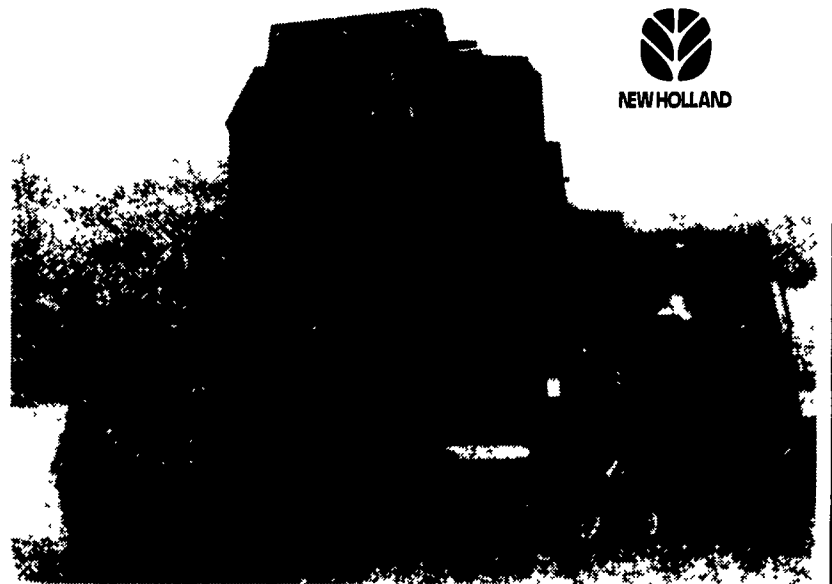
