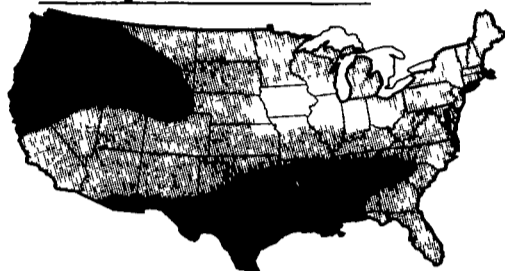

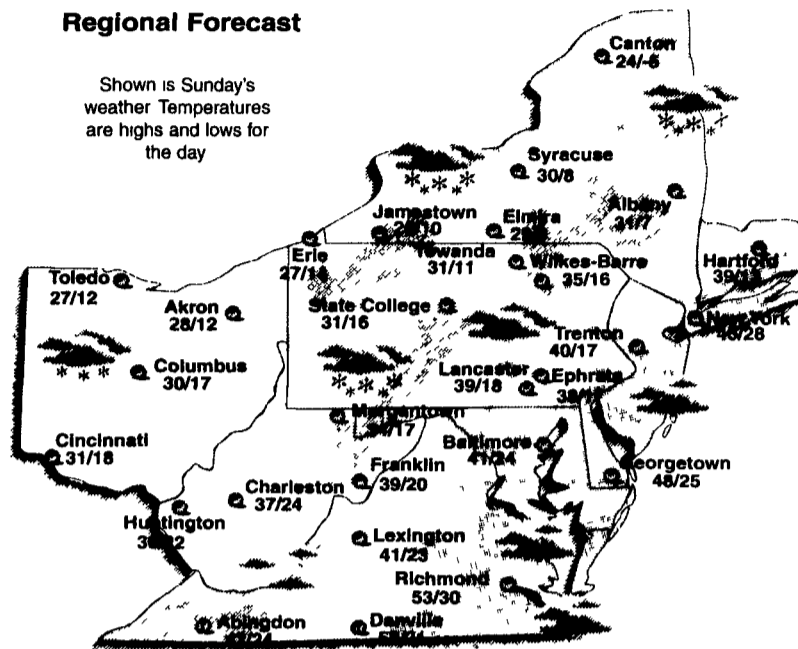

## Regional Forecast

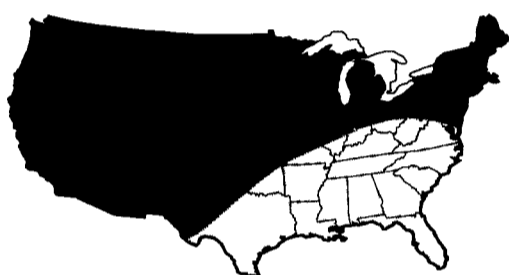
Shown is Sunday's weather. Temperatures are highs and lows for the day.

## 30-Day Precipitation Outlook

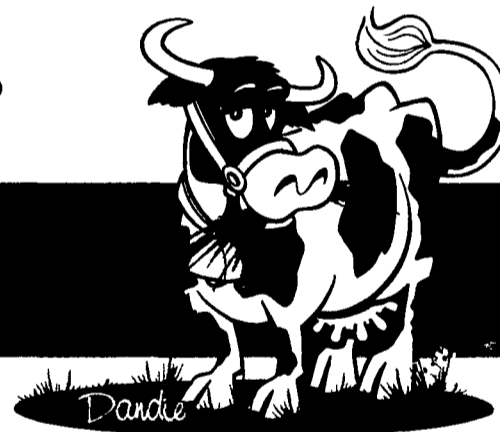
