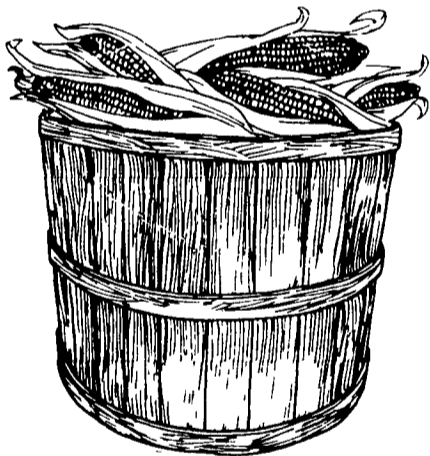

## Deer Creek Can Help!

**Did you know?**  
• If 1 seed out of 12 is incorrectly planted, that represents 8% of your total crop. For a 150 bushel per acre crop, this represents 12 bushels lost per acre. Over 500 acres, this equals 6000 bushels that were lost.

**Did you know?**  
• If you plant a double every 12 seeds, that represents over 8% of extra seed. If a bushel would plant 2 1/2 acres, the cost of the seed per acre would be \$40 per acre at \$100 per bushel. That 8% extra seed would then equal \$3.20 wasted every acre costing you \$1,600 for 500 acres.

**Did you know?**  
• A planter travels 88 inches per second at 5 mph, or 3/2 inches in 1/25 of a second. If there were a delay of 1/25 of a second in the meter caused by poor maintenance or operation, the seed spacing would be off 3 1/2 inches.
