

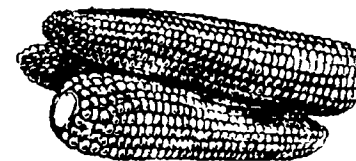
Regional Corn, Soybean Day March 10

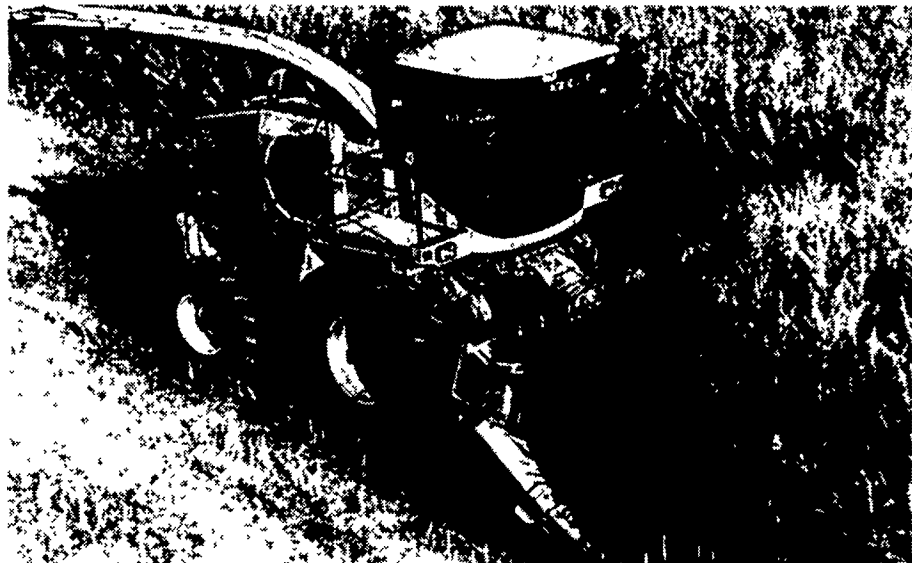

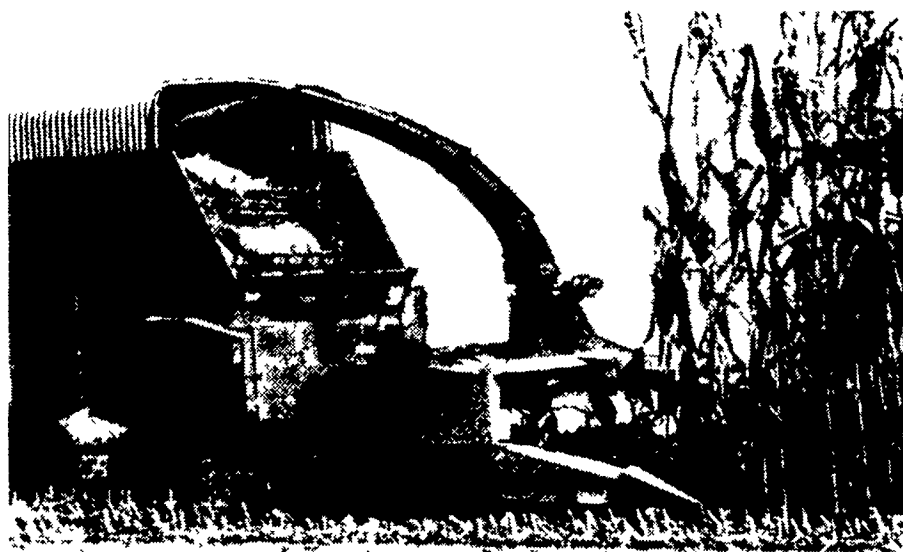
