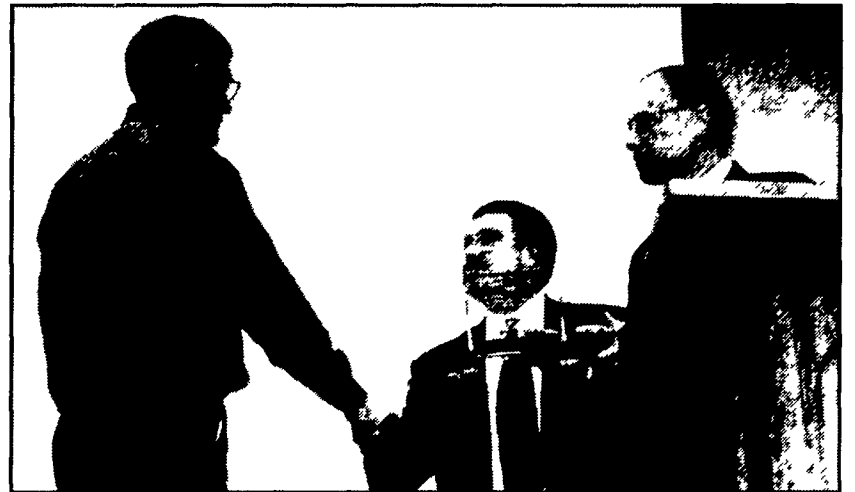
The vocational-agriculture teacher was recognized for his dedication to the agricultural community.

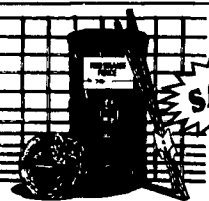

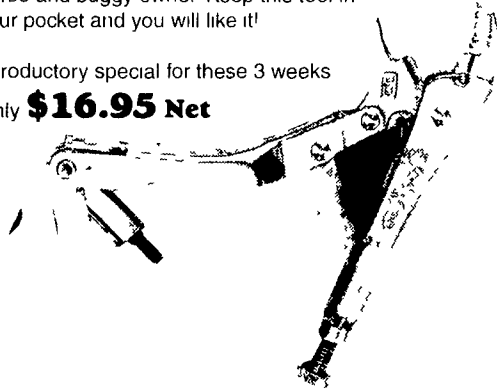
