N.Y. Pork Producers Plan Feeder Pig And Lamb Sale

HAMBURG, N.Y. — New York Pork Producers will be providing a feeder pig and feeder lamb sale, April 19 at 1:00 p.m. at the Erie County Fair Grounds, using the lower McKinley Street entrance.

All feeder pigs sold will be vaccinated for Erysipelas, Rhinitis and Pneumonia, and they will be treated for worms and external parasites. Most pigs will weigh in the range of 35 to 75 lbs. All pigs are New York born and their owners are members of the N.Y. Pork Producers.

At 12:00 noon, there will be an educational class in selection and care of your project pig. A food stand will be open for lunch items.

Any N.Y. Pork Producer member that wants to enter pigs in the sale must do so by March 20 with a \$3.00 entry fee per animal which is non-refundable. All consignors are required to work the sale. Checks

Feeder lambs will be a new addition to the sale this year. Lambs will be born after 12/1/02. Fwe and wether lambs only will be accepted. Lambs will have tails docked, wormed 7 days before sale, vaccinated for C/DT and have a USDA Scrapie Tag in one ear.
