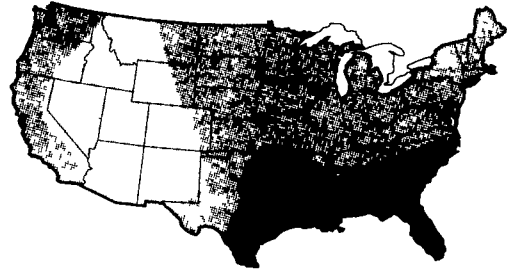

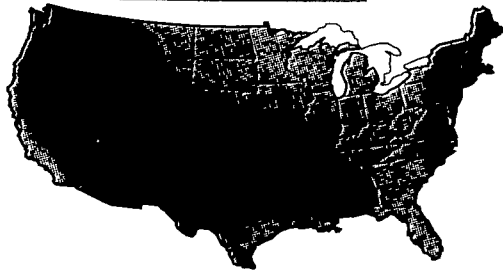

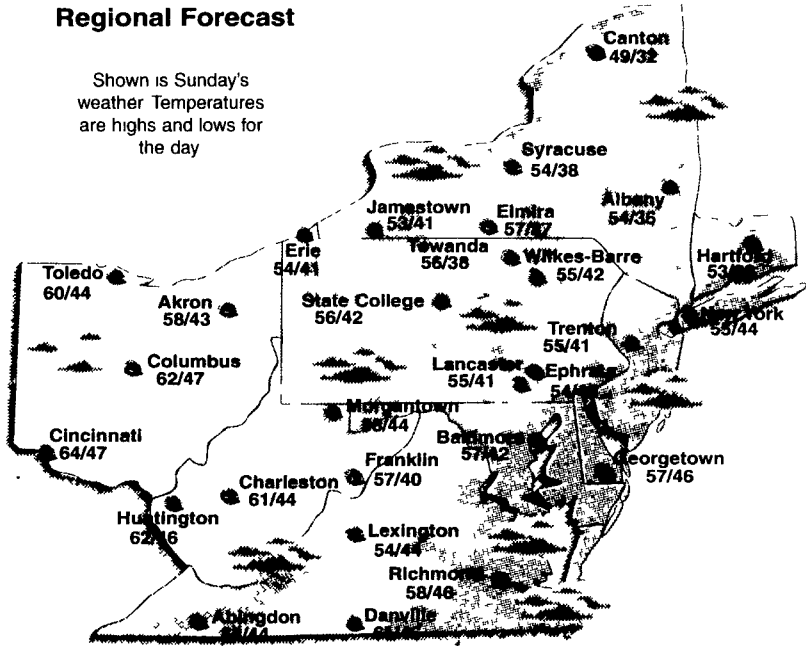

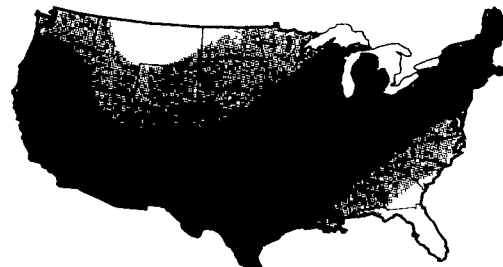

BARIDANA

More leaf and less stem! A late heading less bunched orchardgrass with excellent rust tolerance. Has out-yielded Pennlate at Rock Springs, PA and heads out about 7 days later. Baridana is softer than old hay types and thus has better digestibility. Baridana is a key grass in many of our grazing mixes. We have many happy users.

Plant with alfalfa

BARAULA

A very late heading less aggressive orchardgrass great for seeding with alfalfa. Baraula has soft fine leaves. Our Alfamate contains Baraula and Hakari Alaska Brome. Baraula heads out about 10 to 14 days later than Pennlate. Since Baraula is less aggressive, it tends not to push alfalfa out of the mix. Less clumps and very leafy.

For mixed hay
