
Singer Sandi Patty To Entertain At Poultry Council's Banquet

Proceeds from the fundraising dinner will be used to protect the interests of the Pennsylvania poultry industry and its suppliers.

Jim Shirk, assistant vice president of the Penn Ag Industries Association and executive director of the Poultry Council, said in time of crisis such as battling avian disease, effective communication and advocacy for the poultry industry and its suppliers has never been more important.


