Vegetable Producers To Vote

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) Agriculture Secretary designate Dennis C Wolff announced the referendum period for the Pennsylvania Vegetable Marketing and Research Program. The referendum period began March 17 and ends March 31.

"I encourage all Pennsylvania vegetable producers to participate in this important referendum. In order to continue the essential benefits provided through marketing and research, we must have producer support from across the commonwealth," Wolff said.

All vegetable producers within the commonwealth who grow one or more acres of vegetables for sale are eligible to vote, as are all producers who, for the purpose of selling, grow vegetables in a 1,000-square-foot minimum of greenhouse area.

Ballots may be obtained from, and returned to, the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Market Development, Room 311, 2301 North Cameron Street, Harrisburg, PA 17110. Handdelivered ballots must be received no later than 4 p.m. on March 31 and if mailed, they must be postmarked March 31 and received no later than April 7. All ballots must be signed. Voting results will be announced within 30 days following completion of the referendum period.




