Compared to last week, slaughter steers sold firm to 150 higher on an increase in receipts as New Holland had over 600 head go through the ring in their Thursday run. The quality of the steer runs this week has shown a noticeable increase as the late week run included a very good showing of high Choice and Prime steers, where bidding was very active. The Western direct feedyards moved their cattle from 78 00-78 50 this week which is steady to firm. A continued good supply of slaughter Holstein steers sold steady to 150 higher due to the good demand. The slaughter heifer runs remain very light, and a trend could not be established. Slaughter cows sold mostly steady to as much as 200 higher in what seems to be a demand that is starting to plateau. Slaughter bulls continue to show some weakness, with prices this week trading a 100 lower, although the quality of the supply has faltered as well. This week's reported supply in Lancaster County included 36 percent steers (969 head), 4 percent heifers (99 head), 42 percent cows (1133 head), 6 percent bulls (162 head), with the balance of the three sales made up of 332 head of feeder cattle.

However, someone poured gas all over the late week demand and through a match on it as prices were sharply higher. The 90-125 lb bulls had been trading in the 110 00-150 00 range, until Thursday's run where they sold from 150 00-205 00. The Holstein heifer supplies are not near as heavy as they were only a couple short months ago. However with prices for the fancier 90-125 pounders dipping into the mid to upper 100 00 range, many producers are reluctant to bring them to town. The heifers tested this week sold with a lower undertone. This week the PA Department of Agriculture graded 1024 head of calves for the two graded sales held in Lancaster County.

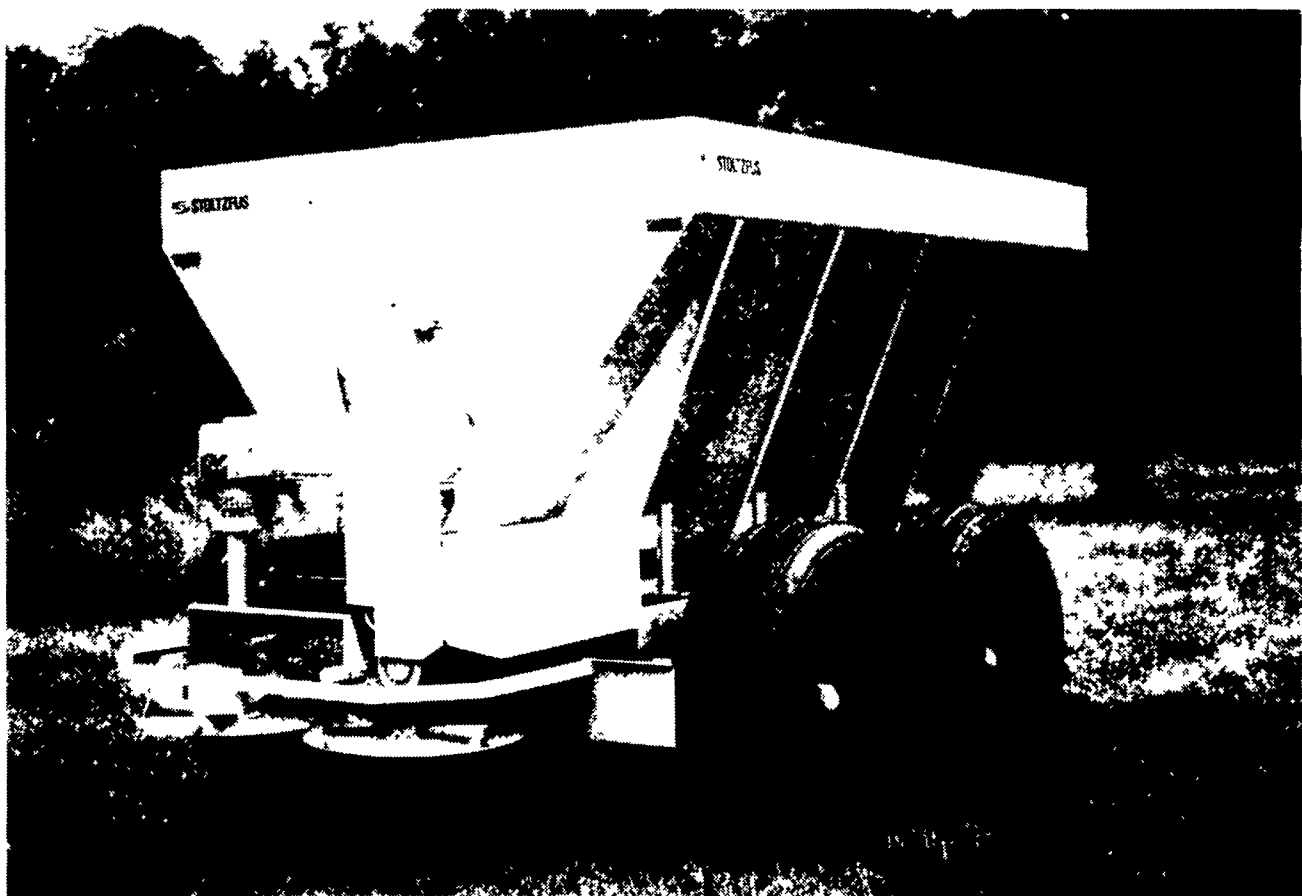
