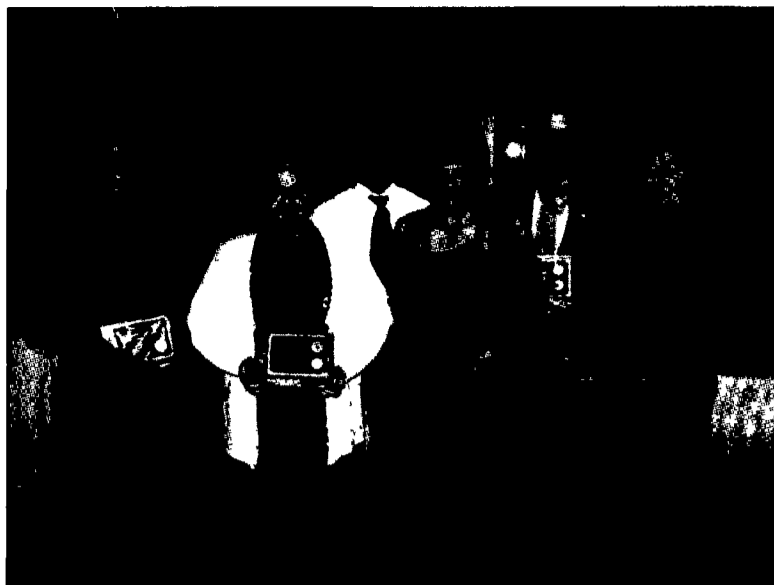
Pennsylvania Beef Council and the National Cattlemen's Beef Association. He also judges beef at several county and state fairs, and has served many years as a 4-H leader.

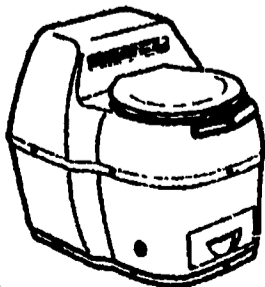
