were acid-stamped "Venini/Murano Italia. He is also known for his postwar Scottish vases with plaids of caning and his two-hole vase, c.1951.

Utilitarian pieces such as beverage sets were also designed by Bi-

anconi and others. Sets can sell for \$700 and up. There are also covered dishes and plates selling for \$100 and up.

Also important is glassblower-designer, Archimede Seguso, known for his variations of traditional Venetian latticino glass, including lace and feather vases.

Heritage Day Focuses On Mennonite Arts And Smokehouse Restoration

SCHAEFFERSTOWN (Lebanon Co.) — Mennonite decorative arts and the restoration work on the Schaeffer Farm smokehouse are the topics of Historic Schaefferstown, Inc.'s April 26 Heritage Day program.

Clarke Hess, author of the book *Mennonite Arts*, will give an illustrated talk on the furniture and decorative arts of the Mennonites. Alan Keyser, one of the project coordinators for the restoration of the circa 1750s smokehouse roof, will talk about the historical aspects and documentation of the project.

The program begins at 1 p.m. at the Schaefferstown Fire Company hall located at the intersection of Oak and Locust Streets (directly behind Plain and Fancy Custom Cabinetry off Rt. 501). Light refreshments will be served.
