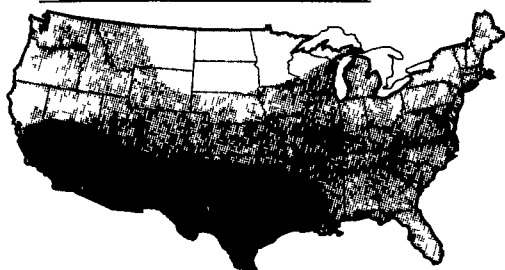

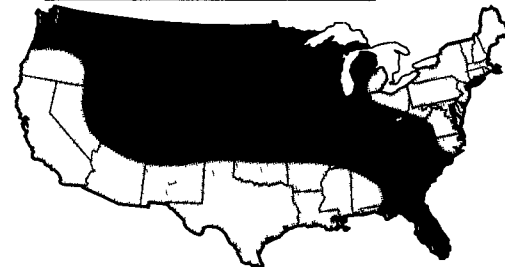

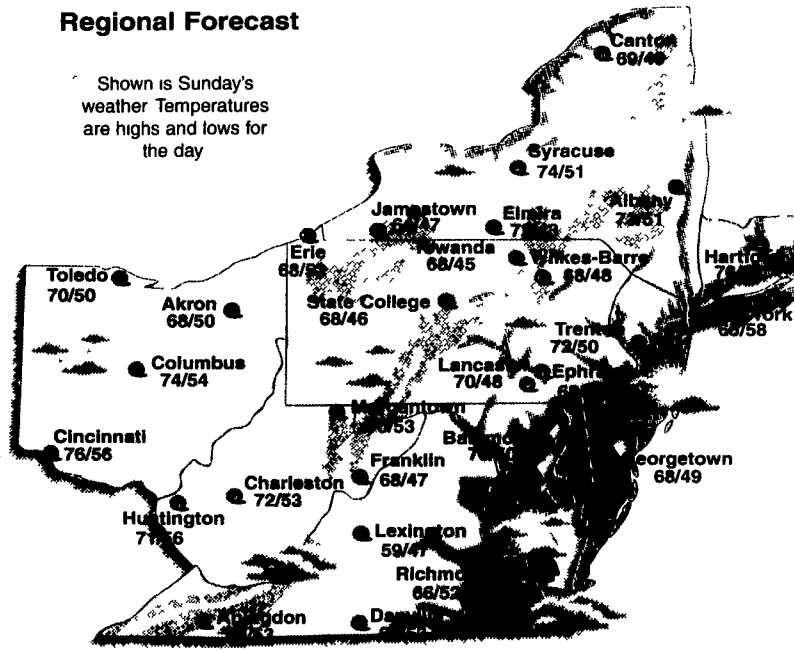

Regional Forecast

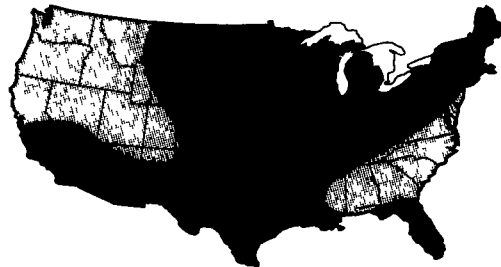
Shown is Sunday's weather. Temperatures are highs and lows for the day.

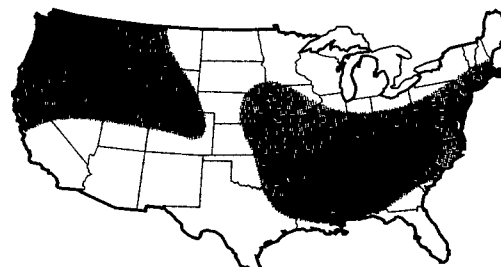

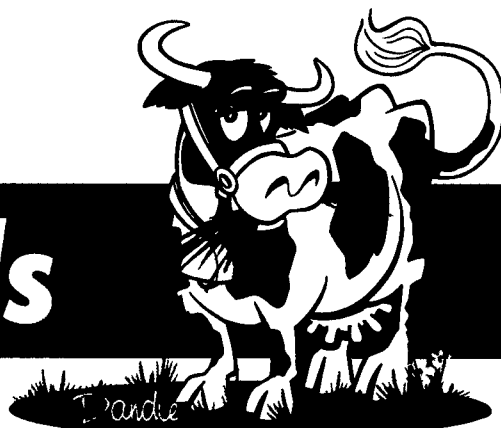

No-Till Summer Queen BMR in to Weak Alfalfa Stands

To thicken weak alfalfa stands this summer- **SUMMER QUEEN BMR**

No-till 25 lbs/A Summer Queen BMR sorghum sudangrass right after first cutting. Summer Queen is a group 6 BMR variety - the lowest lignin type available. It is photo period sensitive (no heading all season). Cut on a 30-day cutting interval, will usually have Nel energy levels in low 70's and very good protein.
