I have a print called "The Flowering Lady" by Renoir. On the lower right it says, "Wash. D.C. Minted. 1912. I know Renoir was a famous painter. It is in an older frame. Is it valuable?"

Many such prints have been made over the years. The frame may be worth more than the print which could sell at a garage sale for \$10.

I have a collection of bubble base bud vases in various sizes, shapes and colors.

They look like 40s or 50s style. Can you tell me anything about them?

M.S. - Walterboro, SC.

You are right that your bud vases were made from the 1950s, on and by many glass companies, including Steuben. Value depends on the maker.

Check for names on the bot-

tom, then do some research in one of the many Price guides.

This glass urn, with a hand-painted portrait of a lady is unmarked. I thought it might be Bristol glass. It is 20" tall including the cover. What can you tell me? There is printing around her portrait.

It would be helpful if you had told me what the printing says; what language, etc. However, from your photo you have a mid-19th century, Bohemian glass bottle, possibly for cologne. Similar pieces have sold at auction from \$350 up.

Enclosed is a vase belonging to my grandmother. It is hand painted, not signed.

Can you comment on the value?

L.B. - Lower Burrell

Your vase is Teplitz-style. Teplitz was an art pottery in Bohemia at the end of the 19th century, specializing in Art Nouveau and Art Deco styles. All their pieces were hand-painted and usually signed. However, if yours can be attributed to the pottery it could have a value of \$500 or more.

I have had this maple armchair for at least 40 years, bought at the garage sale of an elderly couple that had bought it 50 years ago at an antique shop.

Anything you can tell me about age, origin and value appreciated.

Ladder back chairs were made beginning in 1725. Your country-style ladder back armchair was probably made around 1800-1835.

The curved arms are puzzling, and could have been added later, since they are more skillfully done. Similar dated chairs can sell at auction for from \$300/600.

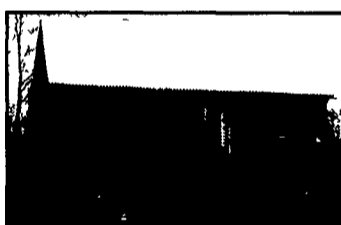
