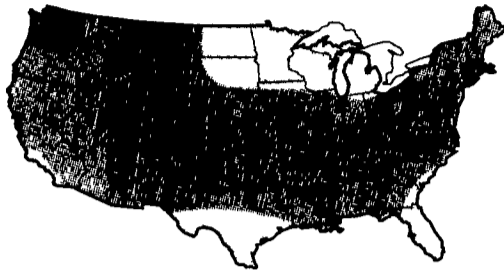

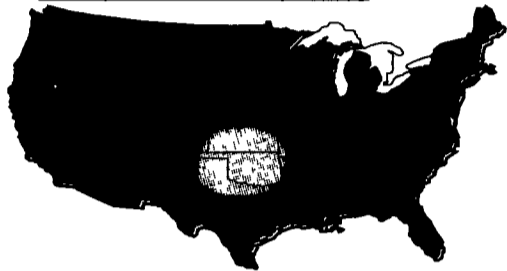

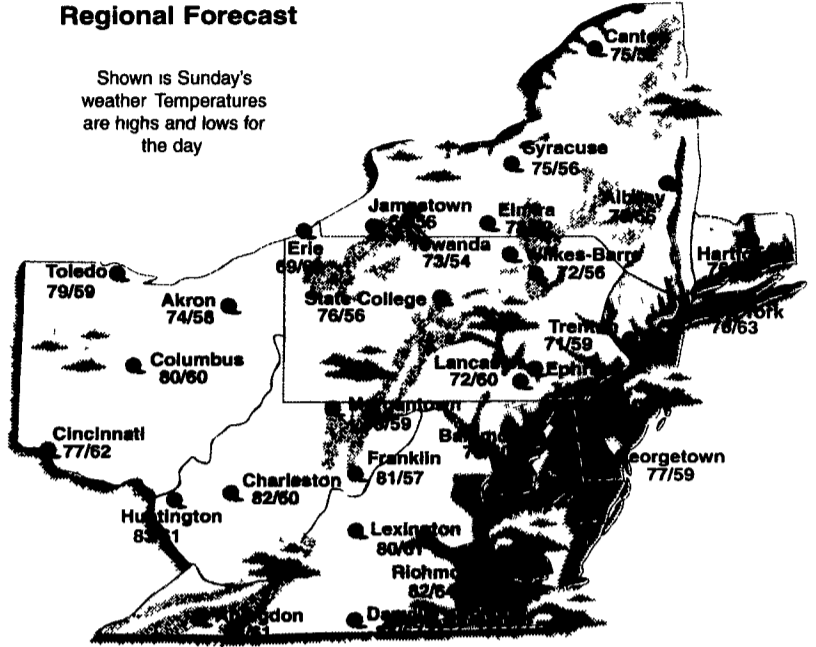

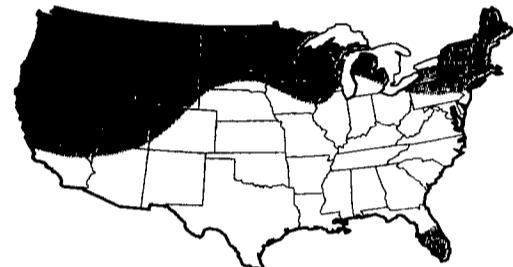

The farm is also known as Fairview Fruit Farm. Look for the red apple sign.
