Compared to last week's light run, slaughter pigs were 20.00-35.00 lower on the lots that were comparable. All pigs continue to go to slaughter as mandated, until further notice. The finished hog market is beginning to show some weakness as 220-270 lb barrows and gilts sold 3.00 lower on Wednesday in Sioux Falls, at 45.00. All sectors of livestock seem to be walking on eggshells, as slaughter steers in Sioux Falls sold 2.00-4.00 lower on Wednesday, with the direct feed yards moving steers from 74.00-75.00 in the early rounds. All pigs are graded on arrival, and sold on their in-weights; with prices below quoted per hundred weight.


