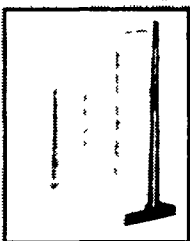


"The biggest benefit is the labor savings."

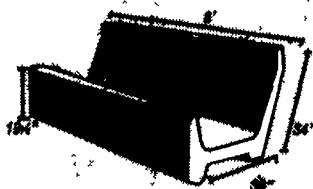

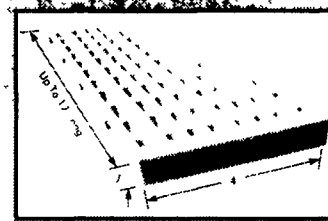
