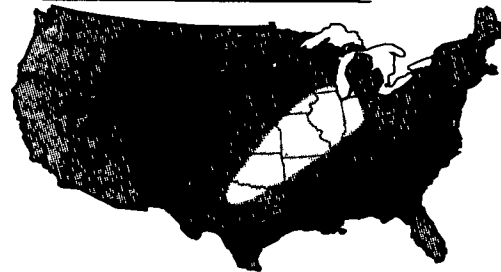

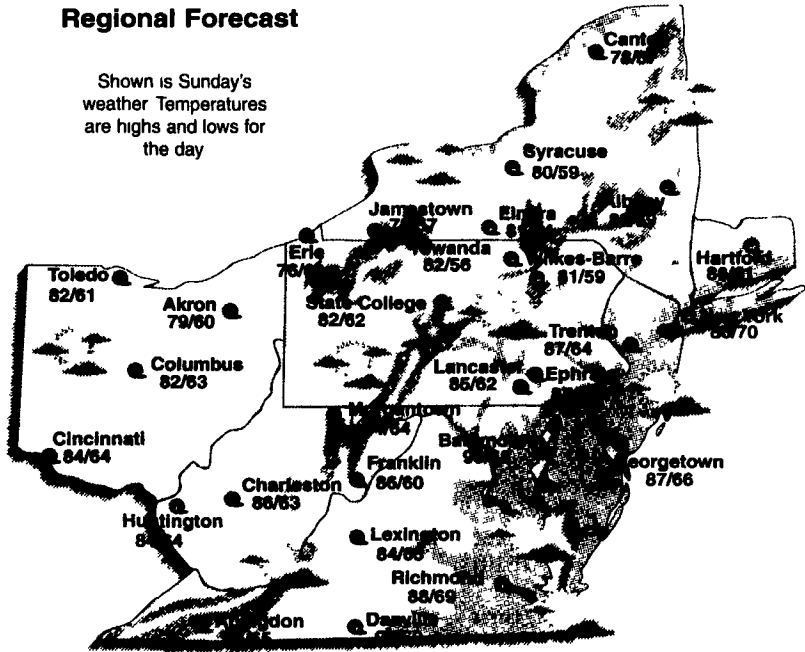

Last Week's Precipitation Lancaster

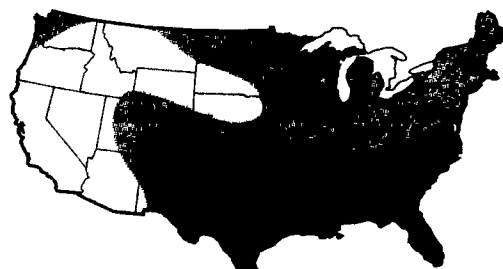

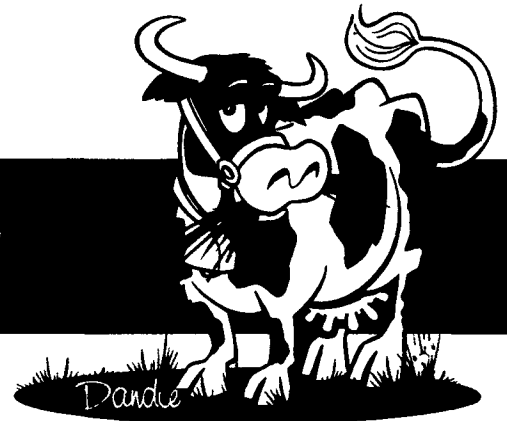
