Myers started building the Red and White herd in the early 1970s. His dad, Sam, had milked Guernseys on the farm prior to Kenny stepping into herd management.

Beside the increasing presence of the breed in the U.S., Kenny said there is a particularly strong demand for Red and Whites in Europe and South America.

Of his cow preferences, Myers said, "I like the good black ones if they have the red factor."


Myers's herd includes four Excellent cows and a number of Very Goods.






