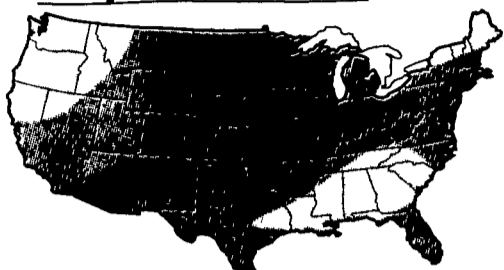

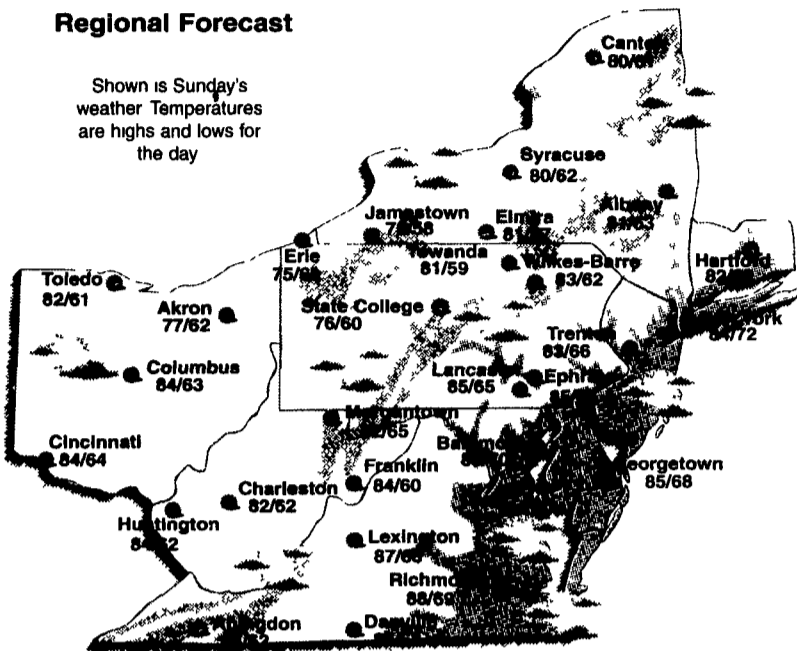

Regional Forecast

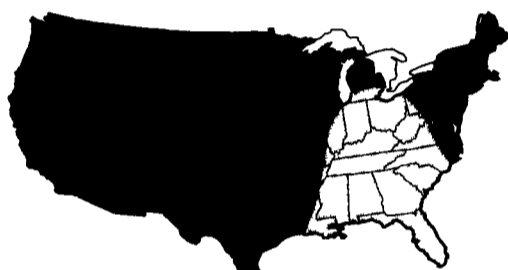
Shown is Sunday's weather. Temperatures are highs and lows for the day.

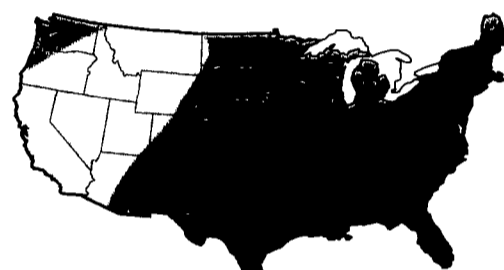

Looks great in our 3 year old and new plots. Top yielder in 2002 Cornell trial with 5.67 tons dm p/ac. A 12" sample taken 7/10/03 had a nel of 0.94 (in situ with high producing cows 24 hr. incubation), a protein of 20.9, and a sugar level of 11.5. This makes milk!
