**NOTICE OF AUCTION AND HEARING TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE SALE OF AGWAY'S NEWBURG TSPF HEIFER FARM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, as follows

1 On July 21, 2003, Agway, Inc., one of the above captioned debtors and debtors in possession ("Agway or the Debtor") filed a motion (the "Procedures Motion") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of New York for an order (i) authorizing, pursuant to sections 105(a) and 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, an auction sale (the "Auction") of the Newburg TSPF Heifer Farm (the "Sale Assets") as set forth in that certain Agreement For Purchase Of Real Estate ("Real Estate Purchase Agreement") and that certain Asset Sale Agreement (the "Asset Sale Agreement") and together with the Real Estate Purchase Agreement, the Asset Sale Agreement, and the Real Estate Purchase Agreement (the "Real Estate Documents") (ii) scheduling a date for the Auction (the "Auction Date") (iii) approving, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 6004(b)(1) the terms and conditions of the Auction including bidding procedures and the Break-Up Fee (the "Bidding Procedures") (iv) authorizing, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002 the form and manner of notice for the Auction, and (v) scheduling a date and time for a hearing to consider approval of the proposed sale resulting from the Auction (the "Sale Hearing"). The successful bidder at the Auction (the "Successful Bidder") will agree to purchase the Sale Assets on the same terms and conditions as those set forth in the Agreements

2 By order dated August 8, 2003 (the "Procedures Order") the Court authorized the Debtor, among other things, to conduct an Auction of the Sale Assets at the United States Bankruptcy Court, Alexander Pirnie U S Courthouse 10 Broad Street Utica New York 13502, on August 28 2003 at 2:00 p.m. (EDT)

3 The Debtor will conduct the Auction pursuant to the following Bidding Procedures

- Bids for the Sale Assets must (a) be in writing, (b) at a minimum, provide for a purchase price of \$1,580,000 (the "Minimum Bid").
- Be received by (i) the attorneys for the Debtors Weil Gotshal & Manges LLP ("WG&M"), 767 Fifth Avenue, New York, New York 10153 (Attn: Marvin E. Jacob, Esq. and Judy G. Z. Liu, Esq.), Menter, Rudin & Trivelpiece, P.C., 500 South Salina Street, Suite 500, Syracuse, New York 13202 (Attn: Jeffrey A. Dove, Esq.), (ii) the attorneys for the petitioner and postpetition lenders, Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP, 1055 Washington Boulevard, Stamford, Connecticut 06901 (Attn: Leslie A. Plaskon, Esq. and W. Andrew P. Logan, Esq.), Hancock & Estabrook, LLP, 1500 MONY Tower I (Zip Code 13202), P.O. Box 4976, Syracuse, New York, 13221-4976 (Attn: Stephen A. Donato, Esq.), (iii) the attorneys for the Official General Unsecured Creditors Committee, Pachulski Stang, Ziehl Young Jones & Weintraub, 461 Fifth Avenue, 25th Floor, New York, New York 10017-6234, (Attn: William P. Weintraub, Esq. and Robert J. Feinstein, Esq.), by no later than 4:00 p.m. (EDT) on August 22, 2003 (the "Bid Deadline"). With the exception of Red Knob, any parties that do not submit written bids by the Bid Deadline reflecting the Minimum Bid will not be permitted to participate at the Auction
- Agway will only entertain bids that are on the same (or better) terms and conditions as those terms set forth in the Agreements and the documents set forth as exhibits thereto
- All bids must constitute a good faith, bona fide offer to purchase the Sale Assets for cash only, and shall not be conditioned on obtaining financing and/or the outcome of due diligence by the bidder
- As a condition to making a competing bid, any competing bidder (with the exception of Red Knob) must provide Agway on or before the Bid Deadline, with (A) a letter stating that the offer is (i) irrevocable until Agway closes a sale of the Sale Assets with a third party (the "Closing"), (ii) not contingent upon due diligence, and (iii) not contingent upon obtaining financing, (B) sufficient and adequate information to demonstrate, to the satisfaction of Agway, that such competing bidder has the financial wherewithal and ability to consummate the Sale Transaction, and (C) a certified check payable to Agway in an amount equal to five percent (5.00%) of the Minimum Bid
- Agway shall, after the Bid Deadline and prior to the Auction, evaluate all bids received, including Red Knob's bid, and determine which bid reflects the highest or best offer for the Sale Assets (the "Pre-Auction Successful Bid"). Agway shall announce such determination at the outset of the Auction
- Subsequent bids at the Auction shall be made in increments of at least \$20,000
- Except as otherwise provided in a written offer that has been accepted by Agway, subject to satisfaction or waiver of the conditions to closing set forth in the Agreements, the closing shall take place at the offices of Salzmann, DePaulis & Fishman, P.C., 455 Phoenix Drive, Suite A, Chambersburg, PA 17201
- If for any reason the Successful Bidder fails to consummate the Sale Transaction, or any part thereof, the offeror of the second highest or best bid at the Auction for the Sale Assets will automatically be deemed to have submitted the highest or best bid. To the extent such offeror and Agway consent, Agway and such offeror are authorized to effect the Sale Transaction as soon as is commercially reasonable without further order of the Court
- All bids for the purchase of the Sale Assets shall be subject to approval of the Court
- Agway, in its sole discretion, may reject any bid not in conformity with these Bidding Procedures, the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules or the Local Bankruptcy Rules of the Court or contrary to the best interests of the Debtor and parties in interest
- No bids shall be considered by the Court unless a party submitted a competing bid in accordance with the Bidding Procedures and participated in the Auction
- The Debtor reserves the right to change the location of the Auction and/or adjourn the Auction by announcing such Adjournment at the Auction
- Such other terms and conditions as may be announced by the Debtor at the outset of the Auction

4 The Procedures Order further provides that the Sale Hearing will be held following the Auction on August 28, 2003, at 2:00 p.m. (EDT), before the Honorable Stephen D. Gerling, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge at the United States Bankruptcy Court, Alexander Pirnie U S Courthouse 10 Broad Street, Utica, New York 13502 The Sale Hearing may be adjourned from time to time without further notice other than an announcement in open court of the adjourned date or dates at the Sale Hearing or an adjourned hearing

5 At the Sale Hearing, Agway shall request that the Court enter an order (a) approving the sale of the Sale Assets to the Successful Bidder(s), and (b) approving the Agreements

6 At the Sale Hearing, the Court may enter such orders as it deems appropriate under applicable law and as required by the circumstances and equities of these cases


