Dairy Herd and Exhibitors Herd were won by Monica Kneller of Kountry Kritters. Club Herd was won by Kountry Kritters 4-H.

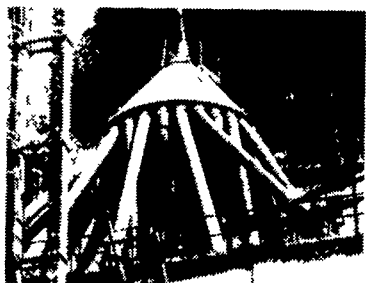
