Tiffany said she used commercial "show feed" to help provide the hog with a good finish. Tiffany noted she wanted to thank her dad, Gary, for taking care of the hogs "when I went to Europe for three weeks," she said.

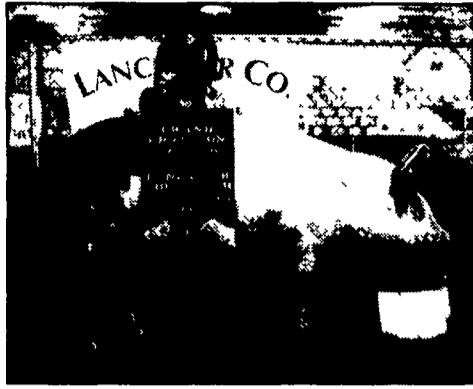
