KUTZTOWN (Berks Co.) — For the second year in a row, Mike and Angela Davis led the same Holstein cow, "Gai," to a supreme championship at the Kutztown Fair Dairy Show.

The show on Thursday featured about 220 animals from eight breeds.

The Davis's manage a herd of 40 milking cows at Mikan Holsteins near Kutztown. They have two children — Mikayla, 2, and Tanner, 5 months.

Jennifer Davis of Leesport showed the reserve grand champion.
