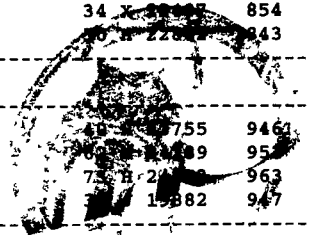

A two-day public sale was conducted for the late Elvin and Martha Hershey of Lancaster drew more than 500 registered bidders, Aug. 1 and 2.

Two floating turtle paperweights sold for \$425 and \$400 at the sale conducted by Witman Auctioneers Inc., Manheim.
