## Northumberland Dairy To Host Grazing Meeting

SHAMOKIN (Northumberland Co.) — Lloyd and Andy Reitz will host a grazing meeting on their farm near Shamokin on Thursday, Sept. 11, from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

The meeting is being sponsored by Project Grass and the Northumberland County Conservation District. The Reitzes are converting their operation to an intensive grazing system. They milk a large Holstein herd. The Reitzes are also completing a project with the CREP program to establish a pasture watering system and streambank fencing.

The farm is located in Irish Valley. From Sunbury, take Rt. 61 south to 890 south. Take 890 south for approximately 5-6 miles. Turn left onto SR 4026 (Irish Valley Road) and follow for approximately 2-3 miles until you reach Hill Road. Take a left onto Hill Road. Reitz Dairy is the first farm on the right.

From Trevorton take 890 north, turn right on SR 4026 and follow for 2-3 miles until you reach Hill Road. Turn left on Hill Road. The Reitz Dairy is the first farm on the right.

Guests must take appropriate biosecurity precautions before attending the meeting: wear different shoes than are normally worn around livestock at home and wear clothing that has been laundered since being worn around livestock.

Lunch will be served at 11:30 a.m.

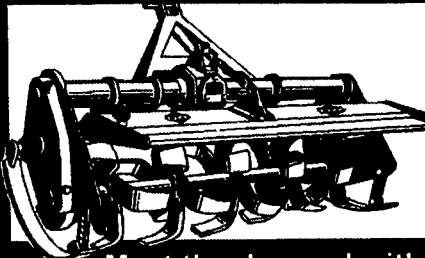

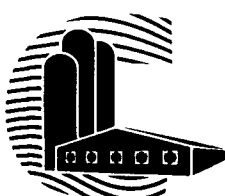
