Rabenold, Billig Families Show Top Swine At Allentown

ALLENTOWN (Lehigh Co.) — The Rabenold family of Kutztown showed both of the supreme champions in the breeding swine show, while the Billigs of New Tripoli took top honors in the market hog competition at the Great Allentown Fair this week.

Samantha Rabenold, 13, nudged her Hampshire gilt to the top of the female breeding swine competition. Her father Carl Rabenold showed the top boar, a Yorkshire.

The Rabenolds keep a total of

about 20 purebred Hampshires and Yorkshires on their dairy farm near Kutztown.

"My dad had Hampshires for probably 40 or 50 years," Carl Rabenold said.

The family began raising Yorkshires more recently — about four years ago, according to Carl.

Samantha Rabenold is an 8th-grader at Kutztown Middle School and a member of the Berks County 4-H Club.

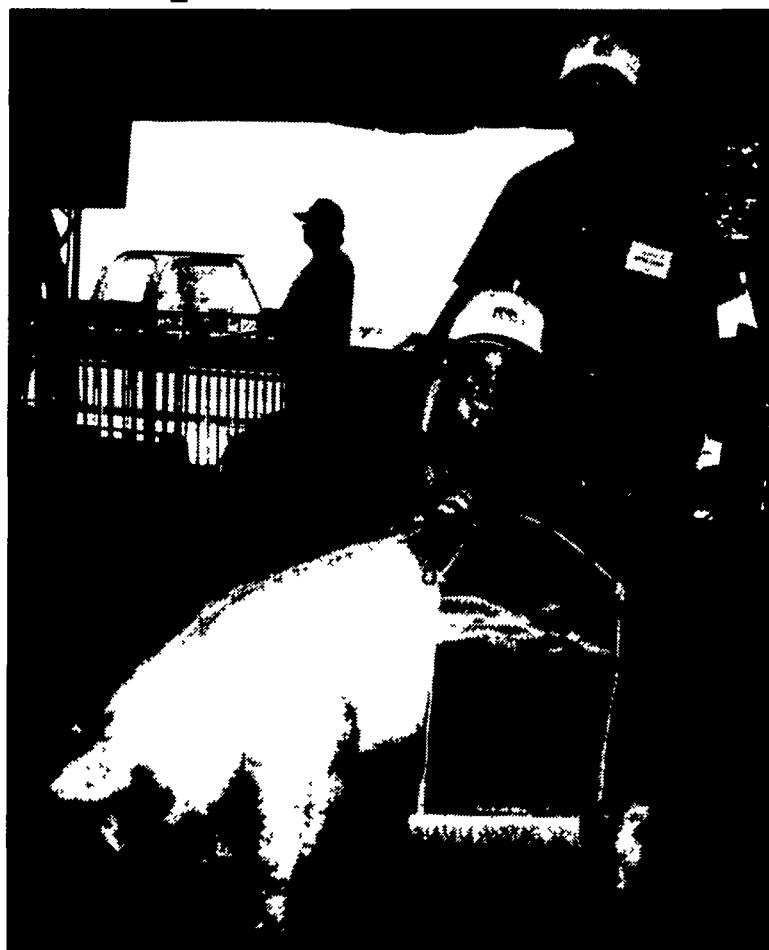
The Rabenold family is continuing a winning streak at Allentown.

breeding and market swine shows, according to judge Doyle Stepp, who hails from Tennessee.

Stepp said he has been judging hogs "a long time."

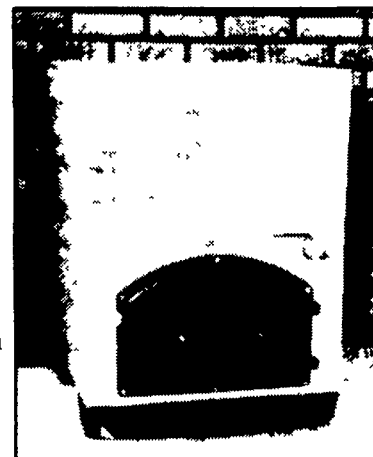
