Eastern Cornbelt Dairy Feeder Cattle Summary — Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio. Compared to last week feeder cattle were mostly 100-300 higher. Demand and trading activity were moderate. Stronger feeder prices and lack of available pastures have lead to more lightweight cattle being marketed this month. The ban on Canadian beef exports was partially lifted this week but the live animal ban is still in effect. Reported sales consisted of about 21% beef steers, 73% heifers and 7% Holstein steers. Approximately 73% of the cattle marketed this week weighed over 600 lbs. Confirmed sales 2150 this week, 950 last week and 1500 last year.

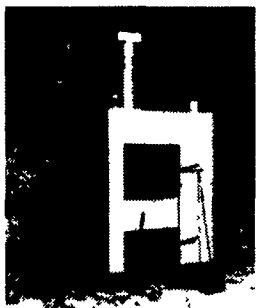

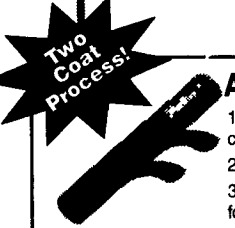
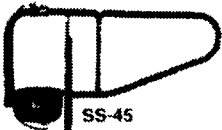
