Compared to last week, the bulk of the run sold with a higher undertone. The U.S. 1-2, 21-22 pound pigs sold sharply higher as prices were above the 200.00 barrier. Bidding was mixed, although fairly active throughout the sale; with buyers more particular than usual on the weights and quality. All pigs continue to go to slaughter as mandated. Pigs consigned to the Wednesday sale are graded on arrival, and sold on their in-weights. Prices are quoted per hundred weight.
