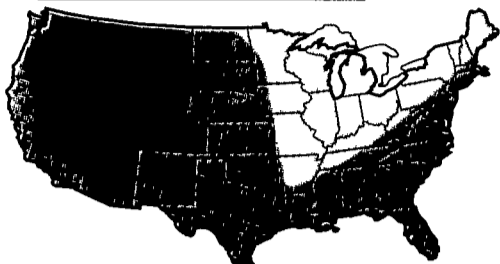

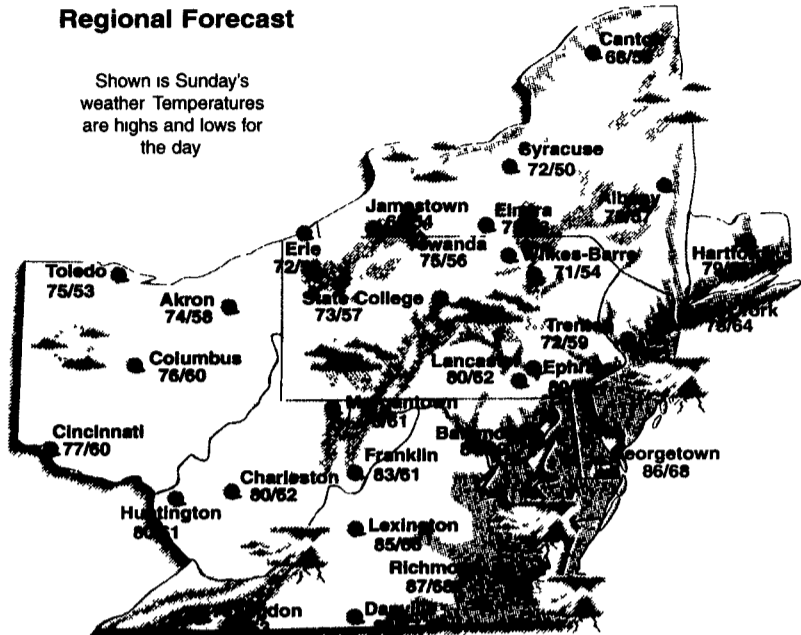

Farming Forecast

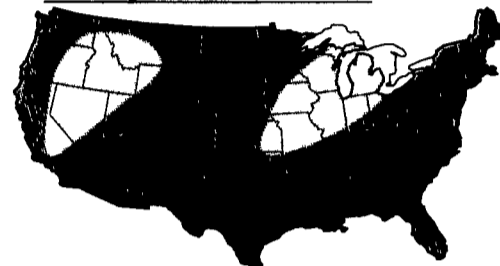

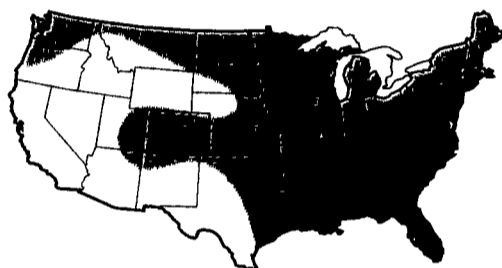
