Negotiated F.O.B. dock prices, 2 pounds and heavier ice-packed broilers and fryers, trucklot sales of US Grade A or equivalent were steady at .55 - .66 per pound; less than trucklot sales .56 - .69 per pound.

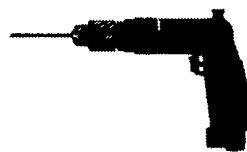

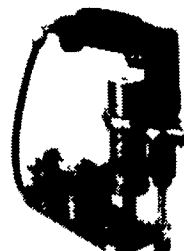
