
ability to provide technology to staff, such as online registration and curriculum delivery and maintaining a state 4-H Website."

These kind of challenges extend to a lot of programs for youth, and sadly, it may be youth who have to come up with ways to pay for them.

"It's unfortunate that, in the reality of today's economic situation, we have to move in this direction. However, most government programs are becoming fee-based," said Doug Steele, Colorado State Cooperative Extension 4-H Youth Development assistant director. "And it's our hope that we can maintain the 4-H Youth Development Program as one of the most cost-effective, highly efficient youth programs in the state."

Our only hope is that the signs of the times don't become the paved roads and common operating systems of the future. Because 4-H benefits the economically disadvantaged, too, and fees are not something they can afford right now.
