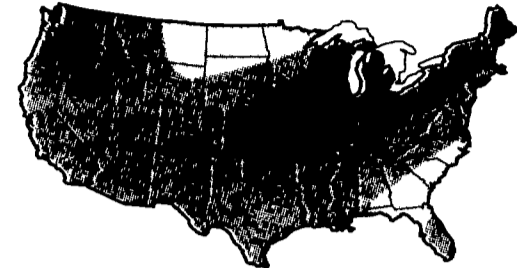

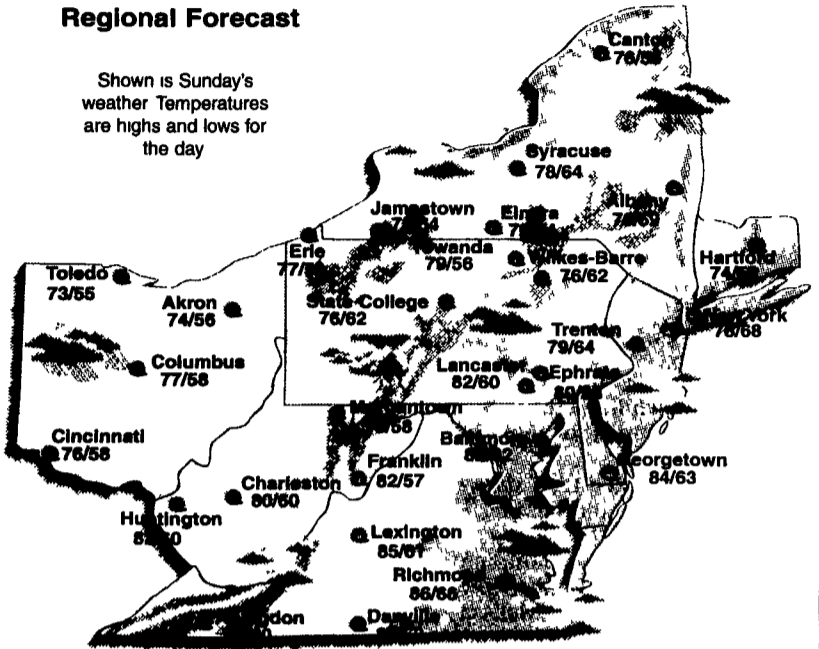

Farming Forecast

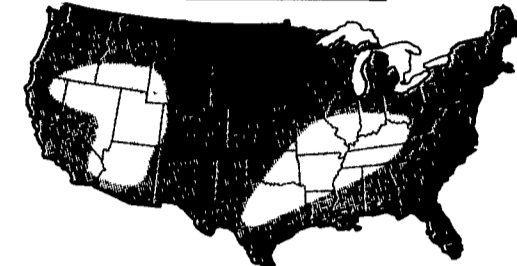

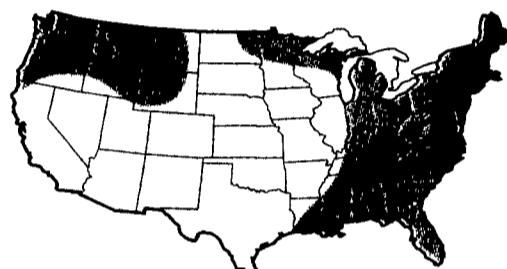

Late Heading Grasses

Leafy Late Heading Grasses Make Great Hay.



Orchardgrass

BARIDANA

More leaf and much less stem are the characteristics of this late heading orchardgrass. Baridana is softer and more digestible than old hay types. It has the best digestibility of all the orchardgrasses that we have tested. Heading date is approximately five days later than Pennlate, giving you more flexibility for harvest.

Timothy

BARLIZA

Bring in the premiums at the hay auction with Barliza. Buyers are impressed with its leafiness. Barliza is our latest heading Timothy (appr. 10 days later than Climax), but unlike most other Timothy's, it can be cut before heading, widening your harvest window. Barliza was bred for flexible management and high leaf to stem ratio.

Alaska Brome

HAKARI

A high energy easy-to-dry grass perfect for short rotations. Unlike smooth brome, Hakari is fast establishing and has excellent up front production. Gives 2-3 yrs of excellent yields. Do not cut shorter than 3". Hakari, along with Baraula (our latest Barenburg orchardgrass), is the main ingredient in our popular Alfamate mixture. Can be no-tilled into alfalfa stands.
