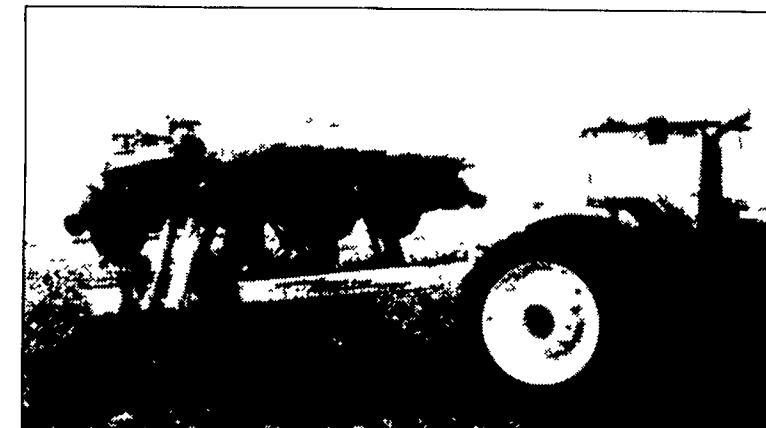
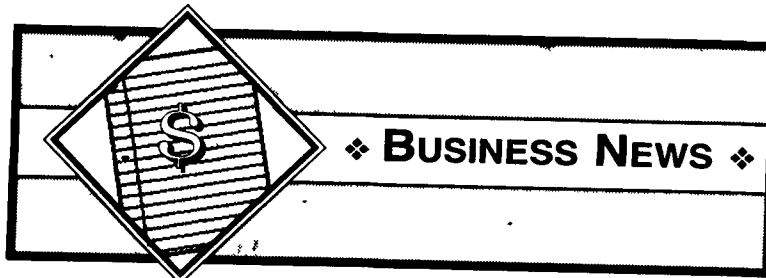

The research that earned Cassell this award included studies dealing with improving the accuracy of sire evaluations and breeding profitable dairy cows by emphasizing sire selection decisions.
