OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS, Weekly Cattle Summary — Compared to last week: Feeder steers over 650 lbs 2.00-4.00 higher. Lighter weight stocker steers and calves steady to 1.00 higher. Feeder heifers over 650 lbs steady. Lighter weight heifers and heifer calves 1.00-3.00 higher. Demand very good for feeder steers, moderate for heifers. Demand good for stockers and calves. Up to 6 inches of rain fall state wide late last week and this highly encouraging to wheat pasture prospects. Farmers continue to prepare and sow wheat pastures and still not all that interested in conditioning calves

Receipts this week 10,494; last week 12,085; last year 10,971. Supply consisted of 51% yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 43% calves; 6% cows and bulls. Heifers comprised 44% of feeder & calf supply Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

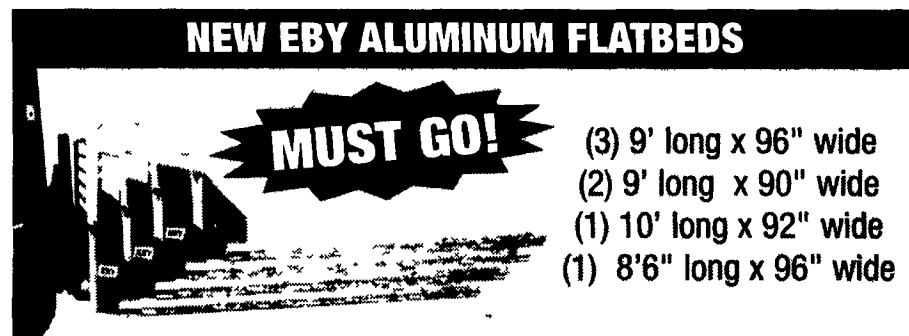

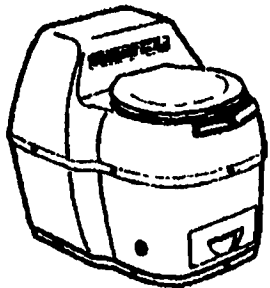
