and this decline means there are fewer voices to speak for agriculture. I encourage you to speak to officials and to be more active in professional groups like the PDMP."

Pat Wood outlined steps that individuals can take to improve media relations in her talk, "Creating Positive Ag Media." "Agriculture needs to be more aggressive in presenting a positive image to the public, via the media," said Wood.

During the business session of the meeting, PDMP members learned that:


