Weights were desirable. Processing schedules were moderate. Supply of bone in breast was moderate while demand was light.

Negotiated F.O.B. dock prices, 2 pounds and heavier ice-packed broilers and fryers, trucklot sales of US Grade A or equivalent were steady to lower at .59 - 70 per pound; less than trucklot sales 57 - 71 per pound.

Wheat bids were higher, while corn and soybeans were uneven for the day. Wheat found support from good export sales. Corn continues to be under pressure due to good yields but the higher wheat trade helped sustain bids. Soybeans saw light technical selling; however, the higher oil trade and poor yields helped support bids. Wheat was 6-18 cents higher except Portland 1-3 cents higher.

Corn was mix, from 1 cent lower to 1 cent higher. Sorghum was 1-5 cents higher.

Soybeans were mix, from 7 cents lower to 3 cents higher.
