Both know this is their last year in the Berks County 4-H program, and both ended up winners late last week at the annual roundup at the Reading Fairgrounds in Leesport.

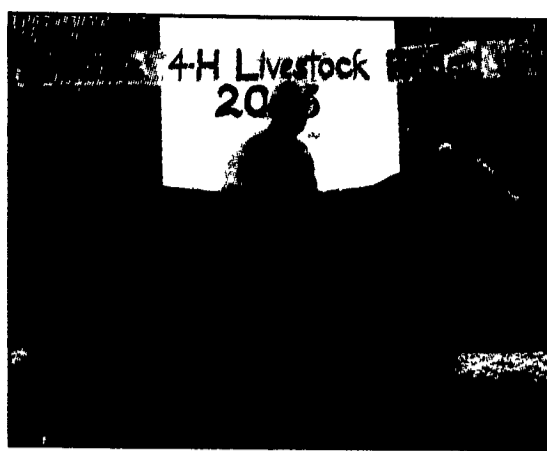
Kristy Dietrich, 18, daughter of James and Donna Dietrich, won re-

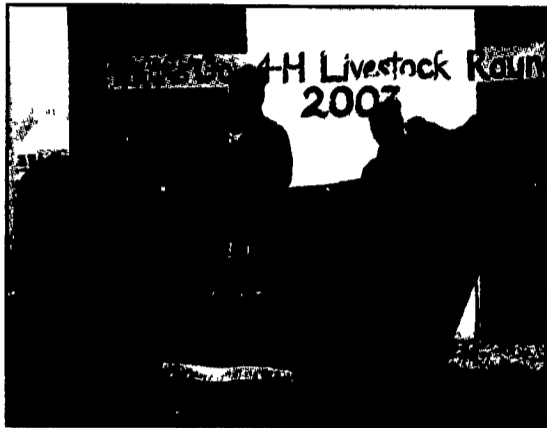

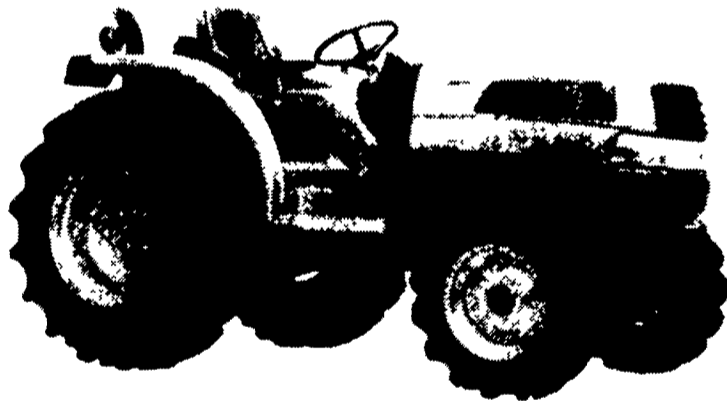
