Cathy said "the best things about (involvement in 4-H) are all the friends and family I have had. Our leaders really helped me."

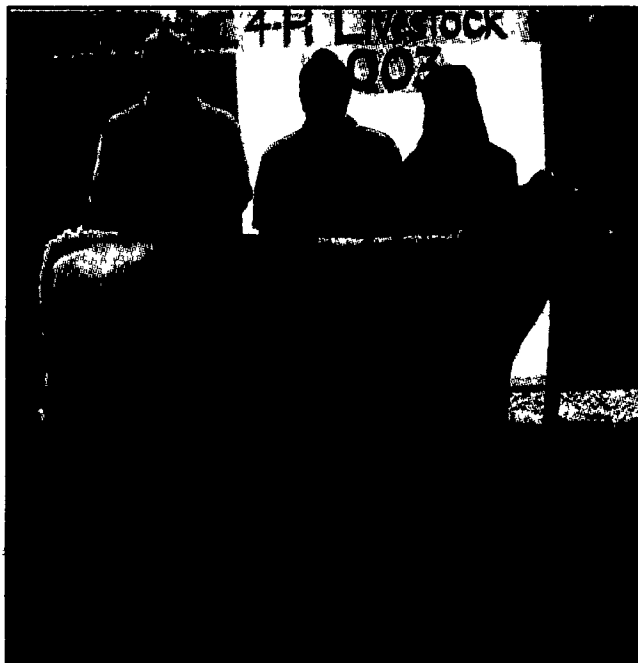
Cathy said that she began showing at Reading Fair when she was 8 years old, with all three species — sheep, hogs, and cattle.
