

Youth Profit From Strong Livestock Sale At West Lampeter

LAMPETER (Lancaster Co.) — Youth exhibitors ran 182 animals through the sale ring at the recent West Lampeter Community Fair Livestock Sale.

The count included 20 steers, 113 hogs, and 47 lambs. Two dairy beef were also auctioned this year — the first time West

Lampeter Community Fair has hosted a dairy beef show and sale.

Tiffany Dean, 4-H exhibitor from Strasburg, sold three champion animals.

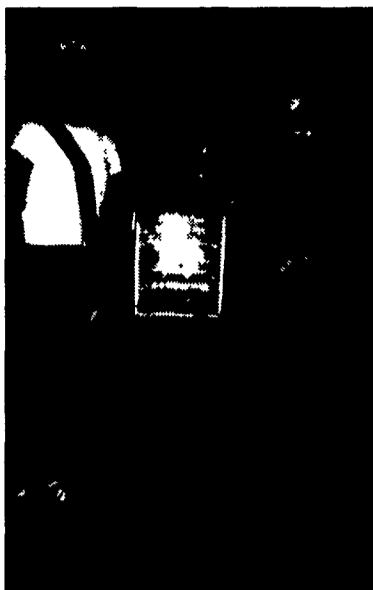
Dean's 1,276-pound steer sold to H.L. Wiker and Sons for \$3,600, making it the top-selling animal at the auction.

Engle Printing bought Dean's 134-pound lamb for \$1,000. Erin Eckman of Manor FFA received \$3,000 for her FFA champion steer, weighing in at 1,346

pounds. Shaub Family Auction was the buyer.

Andrew Herr's FFA champion hog, a 256-pounder, sold to Farmers First Bank for \$1,200. Herr is a member of the Manor FFA.

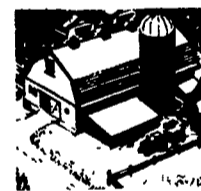
