Bidding activity was relatively good, although buyer attendance was light. All pigs continue to go to slaughter as mandated. Pigs consigned to the Wednesday sale are graded on arrival, and sold on their in-weights. Prices are quoted per hundred weight. The Graded run consisted of 81 percent Graded 1-2's, 10 percent Graded 2's, and 2 percent Graded 2-3's.
