

Youth Livestock Sale Highlights Beaver Community Fair

MIDDLEBURG (Snyder Co.) — Forty-seven members of Snyder County 4-H clubs and FFA chapters sold their animals at the Beaver Fair Youth Livestock Sale, Thursday, Sept. 18.

A total of 100 lots containing 26 market lambs, 31 market hogs, 12 market steers, 17 dairy beef, 7 meat pen of rabbits, and 7

single fryer rabbits were sold.

Grand champion market lamb shown by Selena Hollenbach FFA was purchased by Richard's Portable Toilets for \$275. Reserve grand champion market lamb shown by Kobly Kessler 4-H was purchased by Becky Kerstetter Nationwide Ins. for \$225. Other lambs were sold at the average

price of \$218.

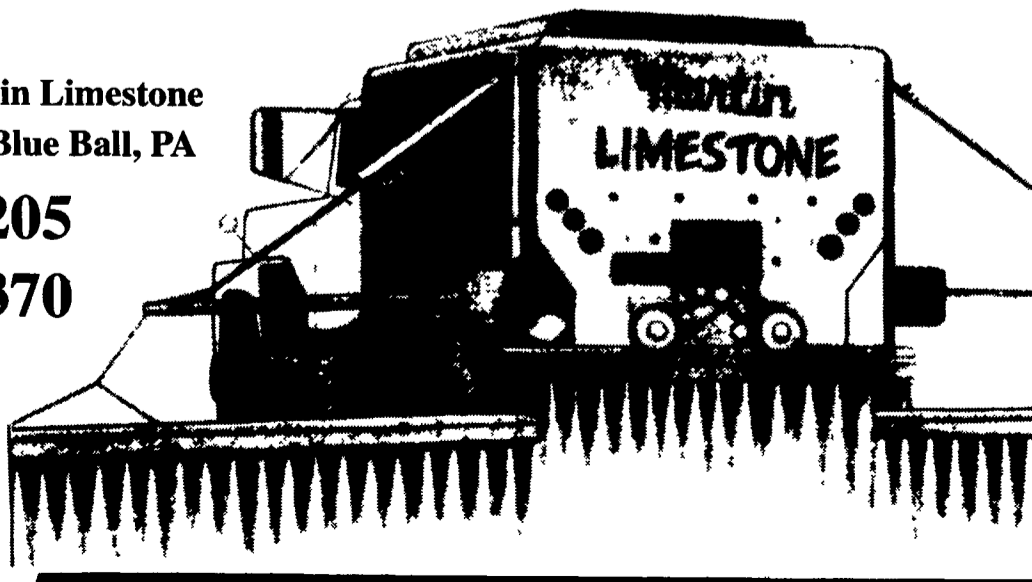
